



2008 Football Finals Press Notes Ford Field November 28-29

GENERAL INFORMATION: Your press hosts today are Brad Heffner, Rob Kaminski, Cole Malitinsky, and John Johnson. Feel free to contact any of these individuals if you have any questions. Brad Heffner and Rob Kaminski can generally be found at the Photographer's Check-In table at field level (not the Photographer's Room), while Johnson can generally be found in Row 2, Seat 8 in the main press area.

Flip charts with lineups, statistics and coaching data as submitted by participating schools, is available exclusively online. Roster sheets are available. A list of game officials is also available. In the main press box, you will be able to find these forms in the bins at the back of press row. This same information will be available in the Photographer's Room at field level.

In the game program, you will find game-by-game results for each school and complete numerical rosters with statistics. We will attempt to announce attendance during the second half of each game.

STATISTICAL SERVICES: Statistics will be delivered at halftime to all writing positions, and quarterly to all broadcast positions. A full booklet, including play-by-play, will be available at the conclusion of the game. All of this information will also be posted to the MHSAA Web site. See a press steward to obtain a copy of a full booklet.

POST-GAME INTERVIEWS: The Lions Interview Room will be used for all general post-game press conferences. An MHSAA representative will escort the media to this area from the press box beginning with approximately 5 minutes left in each game. Our plans are to have one school present at a time, with the head coach and up to three players, beginning with the losing school for the first three games each day. Following the final game each day, we will take the first available team.

Forms for you to indicate your suggestions for players to be brought to the press conference will be distributed for each contest, and picked up 5 minutes prior to the end of regulation play. These suggestions will be forwarded to each coach, but the final decision of which players attend the press conference is still that of the coach. If you need to interview players other than those brought to the press conference, please make arrangements with that coach to interview those players after they are finished in showering and dressing. Coaches and players will not be brought to the press box under any circumstances. One on one interviews may be conducted in the hallway outside the Lions Interview Room and in the common areas in front of the Visitor's Lockerroom and the Photographer's Room. No media will be allowed in the hallway to the Multi-Purpose Lockerrooms.

A microphone splitter is available in the Lions Interview Room for you to hook up recorders to. The jack is an XLR plug. The sound from each press conference will also be piped into the press box. We hope this will make your work in covering the post-game press conferences easier.

LIMITED ON-FIELD INTERVIEWS ALLOWED: Following the awards ceremonies, on-field interviews by Fox Sports Detroit and team pictures, television stations will be allowed to conduct limited interviews with coaches as players as they leave the field. These interviews must be of a walk-and-talk variety – because of the quick turnaround required between games, it is necessary to get one game off the field and the next one on the field. After the fourth game each day, newspaper reporters on deadline will also be allowed to gather quotes on a limited basis on the field.

REPORTERS RESTRICTIONS: Reporters must observe the games from the press box. Reporters must leave the playing surface when the pre-game clock reaches 5:00, and will not be allowed next to the playing surface until there is less than 5 minutes remaining in regulation play.

PHOTOGRAPHER RESTRICTIONS: All photographers (still and video) must observe the field markings. The same protocols will be used as for NFL and college games – with the exception that the team bench area in high school runs up to the 25-yard line at each end of the field. The live network television camera has priority on the sideline, and may stand between the broken white and yellow lines on the sidelines, and enter the team bench areas. The MHSAA photographer may also enter the bench area. All other photographers and sideline personnel must stand behind the yellow line which runs around the field; are also prohibited from working in the team bench area, and are not allowed in the lockerrooms – teams may not make exceptions. Photographers are also required to kneel while working from the end zones. Field access requires a PRESS/PHOTO pass AND an arm band – a different colored arm band will be used each day. Photographers can pick up arm bands at the table near the field. There will be press stewards on the sidelines wearing red coats enforcing these policies. At the end of each game, press stewards will direct photographers to a designated location where they may shoot the awards presentation from.

MEALS, REFRESHMENTS: Coffee will be available in the morning. Soft drinks will be available at all times. Hot dogs, chips and cookies will be available from Noon until 2 p.m.; and again from 5:30 until 8 p.m. exclusively in the press box. **Tickets will be required to obtain food, and may be obtained from a press steward.**

INTERVIEWS: MHSAA Executive Director John E. “Jack” Roberts, as well as other members of the Association staff are available for interviews. Please direct any interview requests you may have to any press box attendant.

TELEPHONES & INTERNET ACCESS: There are pool telephones located throughout the main press area. All calls shall be credit card or to toll-free numbers. There is a single pool phone located in the Photographer’s Room. Beyond dial-up on the pool phones, those media which have previously secured Internet access through Ford Field for Lions games will have their lines available to them, unless those connections are in the Preferred Media Seating area, which has been converted to a radio booth for this event. There is not a pool wired or wireless access point available. Service may be purchased from Ford Field directly for those outlets desiring it. The cost is \$30. You will be asked to pay for the service upon login.
